Every June, Year 4 children in England sit a 5-minute on-screen check: 25 questions, 6 seconds each, tables from 2×2 up to 12×12 . There is no pass mark — the score out of 25 simply shows how fluent the tables are. These three papers copy the real check's recipe exactly: extra questions from the 6, 7, 8, 9 and 12 tables (the ones the Department for Education says children find hardest), only a few from the easy 2, 5 and 10 tables, and never a fact together with its reverse on the same paper.

- **Like the real check:** set a phone timer to beep every 6 seconds (or count “one-elephant... six-elephant”). One question per beep, no going back.
- **Row by row:** 30 seconds a row of five, then pencils up and move on. Gentler, same overall pace.
- Mark it together afterwards. The answers page shows which times table each question came from — so you can see exactly which table to practise next.
- Do one form a week, not all three in a day. Fluency grows between sessions.
